MEMORANDUM FOR GROUP VI CADET ADVISORY COUNCIL & MEMBERSHIP

SUBJECT: Minutes, 29 AUG 09 Meeting

1. The meeting was called to order by C/Maj Christian Chung (Group VI) at 1104 EST.
2. C/Maj Chung welcomed all Representatives to the Group VI CAC. Maj Sacco spoke to the council about expectations, goals, and objectives.
3. Roll Call was taken:

4. C/Maj Chung discussed the role/responsibilities of Representatives for this term council. Each Representative received a guideline which was looked over, discussed, and agreed upon by unanimous consensus.
5. The Strategic Plan of the 09-10 Group VI CAC was reviewed and discussed. C/A1C Rodick (Boca Raton) inquired about the role of Alternate Representatives and C/Maj Chung offered clarification.
6. The Group VI CAC By-Laws was reviewed. C/Maj Chung moved to table ratification of the By-Laws due to the lack of full representation. C/SSgt Wilson (Weston) seconded and motion was passed unanimously.

5. C/Maj Chung moved to table officer elections of Vice Chair/Recorder to next general meeting due to lack of full representation. C/A1C Rodick (Boca Raton) seconded and motion was passed unanimously.
6. C/Maj Chung overviewed the council committee system as laid out in the Strategic Plan. For the month of August, it was decided by general consensus that only the Cadet Activities Committee and the Recruiting and Retention Committee shall be stood up. The Cadet Activities Committee was decided to be composed of Cadets Rodick, Wilson, Urena, McCord, and Chung. The Recruiting and Retention Committee is to include Cadets Zapata, Badel, Di Fiore, and Chung.
7. C/Maj Chung outlined Memorandums/Position Paper assignments that will be due by the next general meeting for the two committees. C/1st Lt Zapata (Coral Springs) suggested the topic be changed to making recommendations to the PFT Program. C/A1C Rodick (Boca Raton) agreed. C/Maj Chung agreed to make the committee assignment for next month PFT.
8. The Cadet Activities Committee was tasked to evaluate the quantity, quality, and implementation of Group Activities for cadet membership, including Cadet Field Day, Group FTX's, and the Group Banquet.
9. The Cadet Recruiting and Retention Committee was tasked to evaluate the effectiveness of Recruiting and retention efforts in the Group since the beginning of 2009.
10. Cadet Training Academy overview and objectives were discussed. C/SMSgt Urena (Pembroke Pines) suggested a stronger emphasis on Drill and Ceremonies for the ALS. C/SSgt Wilson (Weston) concurred and suggested to make GES available for all schools. PT implementation was suggested by C/A1C Rodick (Boca Raton) and C/1st Lt Zapata (Coral Springs).
8. Cadet Career Expo was suggested by C/Maj Chung. There was a unanimous consensus that Group VI should put on an activity that exposes cadets to a plethora of career opportunities in an interactive and hands on way. Capt Samonas (Group VI- SA) agreed but recommended any action be tabled until a follow up can be done. C/Maj Chung moved to table the planning pending further discussion with Group VI Command Staff.
9. C/Maj Chung summarized the meeting events, two Position Papers/Memorandums for next meeting, as well as the topics discussed.
11. C/Maj Chung moved to hold the next meeting via telephone conference at a later specified date and time. C/SSgt Wilson seconded and motion passed unanimously.
